### PLAN SUMMARY

This plan is designed for parents of children ages 3 to 8 who wish to see the very best age-appropriate attractions in Epcot. Every attraction has a rating of at least 3.5 stars (out of five) from pre-school and grade-school children surveyed by The Unofficial Guide. Special advice is provided for touring the park with small children. The plan keeps walking and backtracking to a minimum.

### PLAN SUMMARY

EPCOT's International Gateway entrance is about 10 minutes closer than the main entrance is to Remy's Ratatouille Adventure. If it's possible to start there, you'll be that much more ahead of the crowd. Plan on arriving at EPCOT around 40 minutes before opening. Get guide maps and the Times Guide, and rent strollers (if needed) before the park opens. The most useful Lightning Lane reservations for this plan are for Remy's Ratatouille Adventure, Test Track, and Soarin' (in that order). Get the first available reservation for one of those, and fit that return time window into the plan. If using Single Lightning Lane Attraction Selections, try to get a Guardians reservation for around 10 a.m.

**Notes:** Walk through Journey of Water when you're near The Seas pavilion.
