### **PLAN SUMMARY**

The standard one-day touring plan of Epcot from the current Unofficial Guide. Includes Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Rewind, Remy's Ratatouille Adventure, Soarin' Around the World, and more. Plan to arrive at EPCOT's main entrance around 50 minutes before official opening (and 70 minutes ahead on holidays and other busy days). Get maps and the Times Guide when you arrive.

### **PLAN SUMMARY**

If Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Rewind is using a virtual queue, obtain a boarding group at 7 a.m. or 1 p.m. To use Lightning Lane with this plan: The most useful Lightning Lane reservations for this plan are for Remy's Ratatouille Adventure, Test Track, and Soarin' (in that order). Get the first available reservation for one of those, and fit that return time window into the plan. If using Single Lightning Lane Attraction Selections, try to get a Guardians reservation for as close to park opening as possible, and a Frozen Ever After reservation for around 2 p.m.



## Your Plan Steps

### STEP

#### 1) Guardians of the Galaxy: Cosmic Rewind

**Notes:** If Guardians is NOT using a virtual queue, you'll find the shortest lines at the moment the park opens.

#### 2) Test Track

**Notes:** Test Track is often not running early in the morning and late at night. Before you walk all the way over there, ask a Cast Member (or check our Lines app or the My Disney Experience app) to see if it's operating.

#### 3) Mission: SPACE

**Notes:** If your group includes teens, ride Mission: Space. Skip it otherwise.

#### 4) Spaceship Earth

**Notes:** Eat lunch. Sunshine Seasons at The Land pavilion is the best - and closest - choice.

#### 8) The Seas Main Tank and Exhibits

#### 9) Journey of Water, Inspired by Moana

**Notes:** Walk through Journey of Water on your way between The Seas and other attractions.

**10) Mexico Pavilion**

**Notes:** *Skip the boat ride to save time.*

**11) Frozen Ever After**

**Notes:** *Tour the Norway pavilion and ride Frozen Ever After.*

**12) China Pavilion**

**Notes:** *Tour the China pavilion but skip the film; it's not rated highly by any age group.*

**13) Germany Pavilion**
